What screening tools do providers use to understand arthritis disease progression (pain, function) and need for physical activity? (Prompts in EHR?)

- Physical Activity Vital Sign
- Patient Health Questionnaire PHQ-2
- Vital Sign prompt for those diagnosed with OA/RA

What referral mechanism do the providers use? (Are referral mechanisms built to the EHR and bidirectional?)

- Computerized order entry in the EMR but it is unidirectional currently
- It is different for different providers and regions. Some regions have referral hubs and others do not.
- Referrals are usually unidirectional and built into EHR
